

Modular Course Options

Overview: Students must complete one additional Credit Unit (CU) beyond the standard program calendar. This CU can be fulfilled through additional elective classes or modular courses, which offer flexibility and variety.

- **Definition:** Multi-day (3-5 days) 0.5 CU elective courses.
- **Eligibility:** Available to second-year and potentially to first-year students with faculty approval and space availability.
